- Deliver occupational therapy services at the hospital and in the community, including home visits and participation in awareness days;
- Participate in the ongoing audit and quality improvement of the service;
- Assist with training nurses, community service staff and students.
- Participate in procurement for the department.

3. Essential Requirements

- Occupational therapy degree or equivalent.
- Completed community service.
- Current registration with HPCSA as an occupational therapist.
- Ability to function as part of multi-disciplinary team
- Ability to think and operate creatively in a challenging low-resource environment.
- Specialities that would benefit applicant include basic seating and splinting training and/or experience.
